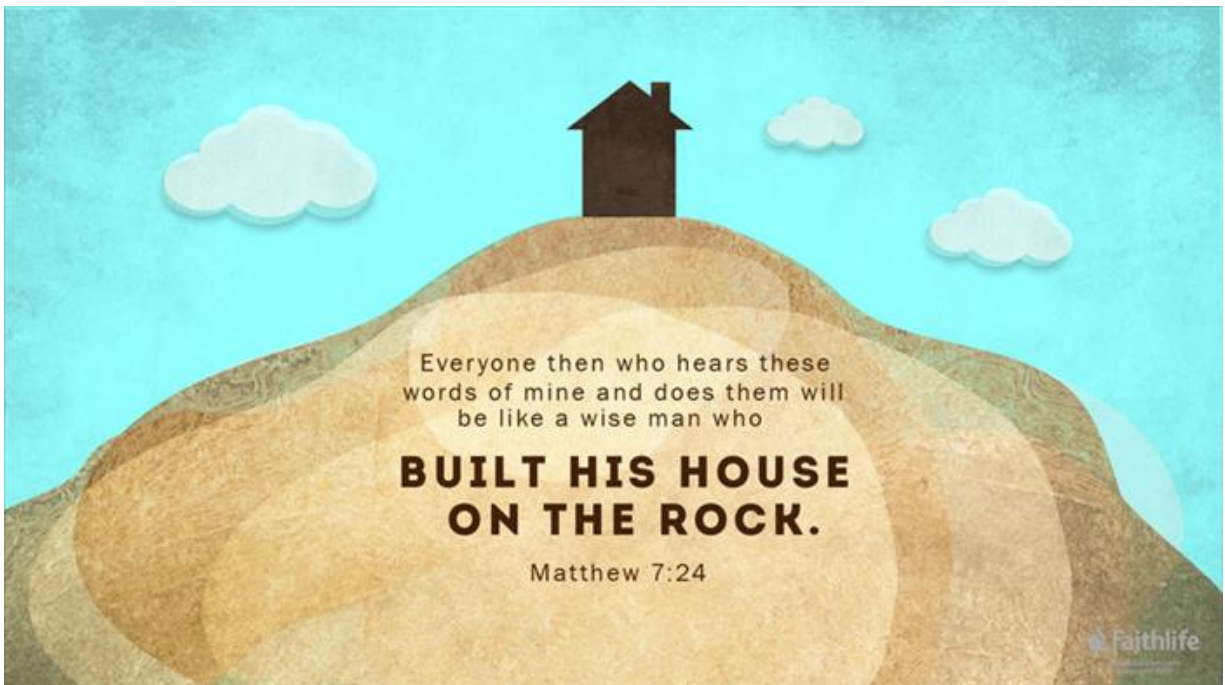

August

August 24

The 1st Commandment & Meaning:

You shall have no other gods.

Meaning: We should fear, love and trust in God above all things.

August 31

Matthew 22:37 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.

Romans 1:16 I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes.

September

September 7

John 3:16 God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Romans 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

September 14

The 2nd Commandment & Meaning:

You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.

Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.

September 21

Psalms 145:13 The Lord is faithful in all His words and kind in all His works.

Romans 12:10 Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves.

September 28

Matthew 7:7 Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.

October 5

The 3rd Commandment & Meaning:

Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.

October 12

1 Peter 2:24 He himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed.

John 14:6 Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

October 19

Galatians 3:26-27 In Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

John 4:42 We know that this is indeed the Savior of the world.

October 24 (Tuesday)

November 2

The 4th Commandment & Meaning

Honor your father and your mother.

Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.

November 9

Ephesians 6:2-3 “Honor your father and mother”—which is the first commandment with a promise—“that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.”

Colossians 3:20-21 Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord. Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.

November 16

Proverbs 23:22 Listen to your father, who gave you life, and do not despise your mother when she is old.

Exodus 20:12 Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long in the land that the LORD your God is giving you.

November 30

Ephesians 4:32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Mark 12:31 The second is this: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no other commandment greater than these.”

December

December 7

The 5th Commandment & Meaning: **You shall not murder.** Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.

December 14

Luke 2:11 Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; He is the Messiah, the Lord.

Luke 2:12 This will be a sign to you; You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger.

January 4

The 6th Commandment & Meaning: **You shall not commit adultery.** Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we lead a pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.

January 11

Genesis 2:24 For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and they will become one flesh.

Matthew 19:6 They are no longer two, but one. Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate.

January 18

1 Timothy 2:4 God our Savior, desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Psalms 147:11 The Lord takes pleasure in those who fear Him, in those who hope in His steadfast love.

January 25

Philippians 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.

1 John 1:8-9 If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

February 1

The 7th Commandment & Meaning: **You shall not steal.** Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.

February 8

1 John 4:7-8 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love.

Matthew 28:19-20 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

February 15

1 Peter 4:8 Above all, keep one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.

Revelation 1:5-6 To Him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His blood and made us a kingdom, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

February 22

Psalm 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.

Psalm 95:6 Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker!

February 29

John 11:25-26 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in Me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in Me shall never die."

The 8th Commandment & Meaning: **You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.** Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.

March 14

Jeremiah 23:28 Let him who has My word speak My word faithfully.

Matthew 4:10 You shall worship the Lord your God and Him only shall you serve.

March 28

The Apostle's Creed: **I Believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He** (continued)

descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

The 9th Commandment & Meaning: **You shall not covet your neighbor's house.** Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.

Psalms 103:2-3 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases.

You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.
