SNACK & MILK BREAK
We have a morning milk break each day. Your child may bring a healthy snack for himself/herself. Please no candy.

We celebrate 3^{rd} grade birthdays and $\frac{1}{2}$ birthdays in our classroom. Your child may bring a treat to share with the class, but it is not required For those students who have summer birthdays, we celebrate $\frac{1}{2}$ birthdays during the school year.

HOMEWORK
Students are expected to study for spelling tests that are usually held on Friday. They are also expected to study their memory work for Monday and Wednesday. Monthly reading logs are sent home each month. We have a different math book this year which includes a homework page that has a QR code you can scan for the math lesson. It is my policy that any class work that is not finished during the school day must be brought home as homework and turned in the next morning. If not, it will be done during recess.



PLANNERS & CHURCH ATTENDANCE

Students in third grade begin to use school planners. They will write down the assignments at the end of each day.

I will ask students about church attendance, and there is also a trimester church attendance sheet for you to fill out and return at the end of the trimester.
