

Uniform Policy Frequently Asked Questions

- Q** Are there specific color names for the clothing?
- A** Colors should be true to the color name. For example, red does not include burgundy. Gray should be a heather gray or cool gray (not light or dark gray). The Policy has been updated to reflect this.
- Q** What are the acceptable fabric types for tops and bottoms?
- A** Cotton/cotton blends or polyester/polyester blends are the intended fabric type for tops and bottoms. This includes performance fabrics such as Dri-Fit.
- Q** Are ILS logos required for tops?
- A** No. The Policy has been updated to reflect this.
- Q** What ILS logos are acceptable for tops?
- A** For tops, the new Church logo is acceptable. Sweatshirts with ILS sport references and Crusader logos are acceptable. Sweatshirts may have last names on the back.
- Q** Are quarter zip sweatshirts acceptable?
- A** Yes, however, a collared shirt must be worn underneath just as the other sweaters, vests, or sweatshirts must be worn per the Policy. The Policy has been updated to include quarter zip sweatshirts.
- Q** Do parents have permission to embroider the Immanuel logo on their children's tops?
- A** Yes, but the logo would be for personal use only.
- Q** Are hoodies allowed at recess?
- A** Hoodies are considered outerwear and can be worn at recess.
- Q** Will there still be dress-up days encouraged for chapel days?
- A** This will no longer be necessary, but the Principal has the discretion to incorporate dress-up days as appropriate throughout the course of the year.
- Q** If a change of clothes is kept at school for accidents, do they need to be consistent with the Policy?
- A** Any backup clothing must follow the Policy.
- Q** Can socks have logos and what length?
- A** Yes, socks can have logos (updated in Policy) but no pattern/design. There is no specified length.
- Q** Are shoes similar to "Hey Dudes" allowed to be worn?
- A** Yes, however, they must provide protection for all types of school activities per the Policy. As always, shoes for P.E. class must tie or be secured in some way.
- Q** Can you clarify the waistband requirements, belts for 4th Grade, etc.?
- A** We removed the reference to elastic waistbands to reduce confusion. Elastic waistbands may be worn for all grades as long as they are uniform style bottoms. For 5th-8th grade, pants, capris, shorts, and skorts that have belt loops will require belts. The Policy has been updated to reflect this.
- Q** What colors can leggings be? Is there a specific legging material required?
- A** Leggings may be worn in black or navy (solid color). There are no requirements for material. The Policy has been updated to reflect this.
- Q** Are 5-pocket chinos acceptable? What about corduroy?
- A** 5-pocket chinos are acceptable. The Policy does not include corduroy textures.
- Q** Are there requirements regarding the belt material?
- A** No.
- Q** Are plaid skirts an option?
- A** Not at this time.
- Q** Are ribbed shirts acceptable?
- A** No, these are not acceptable.
