#### WHAT'S UP AND COMING AT NATIVITY



#### FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

The first day of the 2019 - 2020 school year is Monday, August 19.

#### **MOVE-IN DAY**

The move-in day for the 2019 - 2020 school year will be on Sunday, August 18 at 12:30pm. This is a chance for students to move all of their supplies into their classroom before the start of the school year.

#### FALL USED UNIFORM SALE

The fall used uniform sale will take place on Sunday, August 18. More information will be distributed throughout the summer.

#### **UNIFORM CHANGES**

There will be some changes to the uniform for the 2019 -2020 school year. We are introducing a new, navy blue Nativity fleece, available through the Dennis website. Students will not be permitted to wear the white polos next year.

Next year, students may wear a sweatshirt with the Nativity logo. They may also wear plain navy blue or red sweatshirts or hoodies. Non-Nativity logos will not be acceptable attire next year. Jackets will only be permitted to be worn outdoors.



## NEW SCHOOL INFORMATION SYSTEM

There will be a new school information system (SIS) next year. Per Archdiocesan instruction, Nativity will be moving away from Fast Direct and will utilize Facts. We will send out more information over the summer.

#### IXL

We are moving to a new program for summer math called IXL. This program is a computer adaptive test (CAT) that will help each child work on skills that he/she needs to practice, and the CAT nature of the test aligns nicely with the STAR data given or sent home to parents. This week students have been taking a diagnostic test on IXL. When you receive the password and username today, you'll be able to see the skills your son/daughter should be working on. We strongly recommend that students work on IXL for at least one hour a week, divided into two or three sessions. It's a fun program, and we're confident it will be engaging!

Our teachers have a back-end view of IXL and will monitor how students are progressing, time spent on each session, problems tackled, and any potential gaps in learning. This data will be very helpful in the first weeks of school next year. We have invested in this summer IXL program as it has great potential, and before investing in it fully, we will survey both students and parents about their experience.
