Broomfield Days is this Saturday, September 15! Let's show our school spirit with a HUGE attendance! Remember to wear your red Nativity shirt! Come join us as we decorate the Nativity float this Friday afternoon in the parking lot by the pre-school playground. Decorating will begin immediately following school dismissal.

All students walking in the parade must be in the staging area by 8:30am (space #70 on the South side of Midway Blvd, West of Spader). Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian while walking in the parade. Students 12+ can be dropped off by going East on Midway Blvd. from Main St. to the first turn-around and exiting back westbound on Midway Blvd. to Main St. Students can also be dropped off by going West on Midway Blvd. from Ash St. No through traffic on Midway Blvd. will be allowed for any reason. The South side of Midway Blvd. will be marked with each schools name. Access to the staging area will be closed at 8:30am.

The parade route is approximately 1.5 miles in length. It will start at the corner of Midway Blvd. and Spader Way, and proceed west on Midway to Laurel Street. The parade ends at the west end of the Garden Center. Parent volunteers will be there collecting signs, pom poms, and costumes used in the parade. Students are encouraged to bring their own backpack with snacks and/or water. We will supply some bagels the morning of the event so please get there early or you'll miss out.




Any old decorative throw pillows you are trying to get rid of? We will take them for the float. Please label them "BDP" and drop them off at the school office.
