e would like to introduce you to a new fundraising tool for our school. It's called "Scrip", and it is a program that works while you're doing your normal day-to-day shopping. Through the generosity of local and national businesses, Nativity: Faith & Reason's PTO is able to buy gift cards at a discounted rate through the program and sell them to you at face value! They are the same cards you can purchase at the stores, but by purchasing them through our program, you're helping us raise funds for the PTO. Participating retailers and businesses include Starbucks, Amazon, Target, Southwest Airlines, Athleta, Crate & Barrel, Kohls, Home Depot, Lowes, Whole Foods, Pizza Hut, Dick's Sporting Goods, and many, many others. In fact, we have over 750 vendors nationwide!

How does purchasing SCRIP gift cards raise money for the PTO?

It's simple! Scrip participating retailers agree to sell gift cards and certificates to our organization at a discount. The discounted rate averages 5% and may go as high as 16%. For example, if you purchase a \$100 Scrip card, you will receive a \$100 value card. The Scrip program purchased the \$100 card for \$95, and the \$5 difference is the amount that the PTO receives.

What are the benefits of using SCRIP?

Our PTO gets a regular source of revenue that goes directly back to the school in a variety of ways, including funding field trips, retreats, and updating classrooms and



the school building. Please look for opportunities to make purchases with Scrip cards that can benefit our school at no additional cost to you.

Does my small percentage you earn on the gift cards really matter?

Yes! With everyone's support, many schools are able to raise as much as \$40,000. Because this is our first year participating in the program, that amount will likely not be what we raise, but every purchase matters!

How do I enroll?

Soon, we will send an invitation via email that will allow you to quickly and easily enroll in the program. You may also go to shopwithscrip.com and select "Join a Program." Enter our school's enrollment code: 2D7547L761L7L. Link your bank account to enroll in online payments and place your first order. Have a question? Contact our coordinator Beth Maciolek via Fast Direct. Please be aware that your bank account is confidential; our coordinator does not have access to see your secure information.

This year, parents pre-k through fifth grade will sign up individually for conferences via Sign Up Genius. On October 12, your child/ren's teacher/s will reach out to you with a Sign-Up Genius notification where you can pick a convenient date and time. In the middle school, we are attempting something new in order to reduce parents waiting in lines. Conferences will be "staffings," with all of your child's teachers at one time. Parents are encouraged to meet with individual teachers as needed.






NATIVITY TAILGATE
