EIGHTH GRADE RETREAT

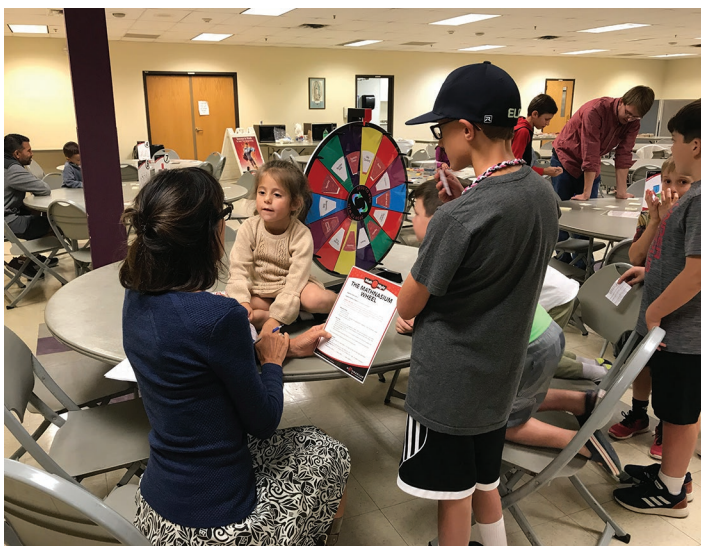

Mathnasium Recap

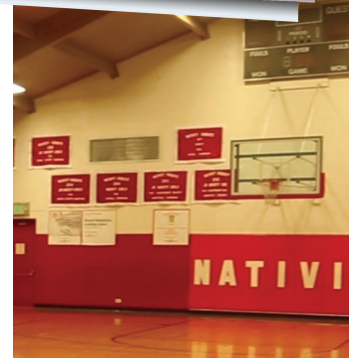
