PASTOR MARK ABRAM

Pastor Mark and Dawn Abram were married on September 13, 1981, at the conclusion of his vicarage year in Bayside, Queens, NY during which he vicared for Dawn's father, the late Pastor Ernst Pflug. They have two children, Jillian (Bobby)Wojcik of Plantation and Marcus (Sarah) Abram of Brookfield, WI. Jillian and Bobby have given them two beautiful grandchildren; Mia (3) and Dash, who turns 1 later this month.

Pastor Mark grew up in Orlando, the son and grandson of a pastor of the LC-MS. He graduated from UCF('78), majoring in finance and economics. Halfway through Naval Officer Candidate School he felt led to disenroll from the program and begin studies at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis in the fall of 1978.

Mark and Dawn began his ministry in Florida as pastor of Peace Lutheran Church in Okeechobee. He also served congregations in Titusville, FL, Virginia and Wisconsin and as a mission developer for the New Jersey District in the Princeton area. Most recently he retired from Trinity Lutheran Church in The Villages, FL earlier this year, where he served since 2005. Ideas on How to Invite People to Attend Worship Services

Pray for the unchurched in our community. Pray for children being raised outside the church, couples in marriages that don't have Christ at their center, etc. But pray also for specific families and individuals – friends, relatives, associates, neighbors – by name every day!

Know that personal invitations are the most effective method of increasing worship attendance. Invest 60 seconds once a week to invite someone to attend worship with you.

Continue to invite a person every two months even if they decline you invitations. Those invited may eventually come to a season of life when they are receptive to attending worship. Regular invitations are more likely to overlap one of these seasons.

Keep Sunday's bulletin in your car or on your desk until you have given it to someone along with your personal invitation for them to join you in worship.



James 2:2 "For if a man wearing a gold ring and fine clothing comes into your assembly, and a poor man in shabby clothing also comes in. . ." God shows no partiality: rich and poor alike are called into the Kingdom. Both rich and poor alike have something to contribute to the Kingdom in accordance with the callings God has given them in their lives.
