VOLUNTEER SERVICE HOURS

Every Kindergarten—8th Grade Family is required to participate in fifteen (15) hours of school designated volunteer service hours. Your services are greatly needed and appreciated. Families are subject to a \$200 fee if volunteer hours are not met. If you can't meet your required hours, we will take your money—but we prefer your time.

Reminder - Of the 15 volunteer hours only a maximum of 5 hours can come from class field trips.

Steps to Take to Complete Hours:

- 2. Parents complete a volunteer event.
- 3. Parents submit a Volunteer Hours record with the Volunteer Supervisor's signature and return it to the school office (NOTE: It is not the Volunteer Supervisor's responsibility to turn in hours for parents).
- 4. Hours are logged in by a Peace volunteer monthly and monitored for fifteen (15) hour completion by May 1.
