Short Notes from Home & School Connection Excellent Attendance

Being in school every day means your child won't miss out on learning. Try to schedule appointments and family trips outside of school hours. If he asks to stay home "just because," remind him of what he'll miss, such as his reading group or PE class. Explain that he can be absent only if he is really sick or if there's a family emergency.

Did you know?

Children who regularly eat meals with their families tend to do better in school and avoid risky behavior. Eating dinner together is great, but other meals count too. If you work at night, maybe you could make time for a family breakfast. Or on a weekend try a picnic lunch.

Celebrate progress

Suggest that your youngster create a fun reminder all the things she has accomplished. Let her cover a box with construction paper and label it "I did it!" Then, she can write each success (such as "I learned to add fractions") on a slip of paper and put it in the box. If she is feeling discouraged, have her read the slips.

October Chapel Project -Hurricane Relief Assistance

Our October chapel offering will help the restoration efforts of Lutheran South Academy in Houston, Texas. They received extensive flood damage from Hurricane Harvey last month. When they assessed their needs they found the following:

- * Extensive building damage making it unusable for a month with construction continuing until January 2018. The entire student body has been temporarily relocated to a nearby church until school buildings are safe to occupy.
- * Lost a tremendous amount of classroom and extracurricular content that will well exceed the insurance coverage.
- * Eight staff members were completely flooded out of their homes and have had to relocate.
- * Over 40 school families had flood waters in their home with some homes being deemed a complete loss.



Please join with the entire SBL Church & School Family in helping our brothers and sisters in Christ in Houston, Texas. 100% of our chapel offerings will be added to the contributions collected in church to help these folks recover from this devastating event. And, The Lutheran Foundation of Fort Wayne is matching contributions from Lutheran churches \$200,000 schools up to (by October 31). The matching funds will be channeled through the
