Writing that makes sense

As your child first learns to write, his stories may not always make sense to others. His words may even be confusing because he is using his own creative spelling. That is ok. Help his writing flow logically with these ideas.

1. Even if your youngster isn't writing perfect sentences just yet, he can share his ideas in written form. Encourage him to write words as he sees them. Encourage him to tell you the stories if he needs to. But encourage him to compose. Have him write about a new activity in the classroom or something funny that happened at lunch. Describe putting things in a logical order so when he

puts his thoughts down on paper it makes sense.

2. Let your child read his stories to you. Ask questions to encourage him to add information or clear up a confusing part.

You might be amazed at what your child can write at an early age.
