Even though the end of the school year is a long way off, I want to make sure all of you are aware of the collection policy for the final month of pre-school fees. This does not affect all of you who make your monthly payment on time. It only has impact on anyone who does not make payments at the first of each month.

Throughout the year, tuition is due on the first of each month. However, removal from school does not happen until some time after payment is in arrears. The final payment, due on May 1, is not allowed to go past due further than 15 days. On the 16th day of May any child who is not current on all fees will not be allowed to continue in attendance. While it would be very sad for us to see your child not complete the school year, we find a financial responsibility to collect all fees before the school year is over.

Please make note of this policy and plan your payments accordingly.
