Nursery & Pre-k Parents

First, may I say that the collection of fees from pre-school families has been an overall easy task once again this year. Most of you have been very faithful in making your payments on time. **Thank you very much!** As a result of that, I don't think the following is of much concern. Yet, I need to make sure there are no miscommunications.

Throughout the year, tuition is due on the first of each month. The final payment, due on May 1, is not allowed to go past due further than 15 days. On the 16th day of May any child who is not current on all fees will not be allowed to continue

in attendance. While it would be very sad for us to see your child not complete the school year, we find a financial responsibility to collect all fees before the school year is over. Please make note of this policy and plan your payments accordingly.

IMPORTANT SBLS Financial Aid for 2018-19

Every year we have some money available from our own school tuition assistance funds. These funds are distributed based solely on financial need of the recipient. We are no longer using Private School Aid Service. Those who want to apply, fill out an application that you receive from the school office. There is no longer an application fee either.

This must be received in our office by May 25, 2018. While a small amount of funds may be available at a later date the majority of our assistance is designated to those who meet the May 25 deadline.
