The 2022-2023 school year dress down days are as follows:

Please remember that while the students do not need to wear their uniforms on the above dates, proper school attire is still required although jeans are permissible. Proper attire includes: no hooded sweatshirts, no open-toe or open-back shoes, no short shorts, no tank tops, and no inappropriate logos.

We ask that for each day that your child chooses to dress down that you donate \$2 dollars to the dress down fund. If it is easier, you can write one check (payable to St. Brigid School) for \$20 per child at the outset and this will cover all of the dress down days for the year. We will be voting on how to allocate the dress down funds at the October HSA meeting, and all are welcome to attend and participate.
