2021-2022 School Year

Enrollment for the 2021-2022 school year is open! All families, new and returning must enroll. It is best to enroll early to secure your seat for the next school year. To be fully enrolled, all families must complete the online process, submit **PROOF OF RESIDENCY** and complete and return **ALL** of the forms that were included in the enrollment packet. COVID testing kits

All Wisconsin residents are able to request a FREE at home COVID saliva testing kit. You do not have to be symptomatic to take the test. It is delivered directly to your home, the saliva swab is conducted in the presence of a licensed medical professional via Zoom, and you then drop off your collection kit at a designated UPS location.
