<b>10/1</b>	<b>The Fourth Commandment</b>

<b>10/22</b>	<b>The Seventh Commandment</b>
	You shall not steal.  <i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.
<b>10/24</b>	<b>Genesis 50:20</b>
	But as for you, you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as it is this day, to save many people alive.
<b>10/27</b>	<b>Exodus 34:6</b>
	And the Lord passed before him and proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth,
<b>10/29</b>	<b>The Eighth Commandment</b>
	You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.  <i>What does this mean?</i> We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.
<b>10/31</b>	<b>John 17:3</b>
	And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.
