Tuition rates and the payment schedules are established and approved by the Parish Finance Committee each year. For the upcoming school year, all instructional fees have been incorporated into the tuition values below. It is within the discretion of the School Board and/or the Parish Finance Committee to establish tuition rates and schedules supporting the effective and efficient operation of the parish school. While highly unlikely, it is possible for tuition rates and/or schedules to be altered during the school year should the need arise.

2018 – 2019 Annual Tuition

1 Child	\$ 5,500	(\$500 monthly)
2 nd Child	\$ 2,750	(\$250 monthly)
3 rd Child	\$ 2,200	(\$200 monthly)
4 th or more (per child)	\$ 55	(\$ 5 monthly)

A **non-refundable registration** fee of \$300 per family is required. Families registering by **2/28/2018**, may submit a reduced registration fee of **\$200**. New family registration fee is \$200.

MONTHLY tuition payments will be paid July 2018 through May 2019 by ACH, credit card, or MO MO\$T 529 distribution.

ANNUAL single tuition payments qualify for a \$100 discount, and must be received on or before July 20, 2018 to qualify for the discount. In addition to ACH, credit card or Personal checks will be accepted for ANNUAL payments.

SEMI-ANNUAL payments will be paid in July 2018 and January 2019 by ACH, credit card, or MO MO\$T 529 distribution. MO MO\$T payments will qualify for a \$50 per semester discount since annual MO\$T payments cannot be distributed for multiple calendar tax years.

Open application period for financial aid is January 29, 2018 to February 28, 2018.

We strongly encourage all families to apply for tuition assistance.

If your account becomes delinquent due to transaction failure and you have not made arrangements with the Parish Office, the following penalties will occur:

- If your tuition account is past due, you will be denied access to your child’s grades via Fast Direct.
- If your account is 60 days past due, your child will not be able to return to school until the balance is paid.
- 8th grade students will not be allowed to participate in activities such as 8th Grade Day Out or Graduation Mass or Dinner until all financial obligations have been met.
- Student’s records and transcripts will not be transferred to any school or institution.
- Continued tuition delinquencies may result in denied entry to St. Paul School.

WITNESS STATEMENT
For Those Whose Children Attend Catholic Education Programs

One of the supreme gifts of marriage is bringing forth new life. God entrusts children to parents who have a primary right and duty to educate their children in the practice of their faith. Parents carry out this responsibility by creating a home full of love, forgiveness, respect, and fidelity. The family is the community in which, from childhood, one honors God and learns moral values.

In the rite of the sacrament of Baptism, parents receive the call from God to evangelize their children, as here summarized:

You have asked to have your child baptized. In doing so you are accepting the responsibility of training him (her) in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring him (her) up to keep God's commandments as Christ taught us, by loving God and our neighbor.... You will be the first teachers of your child in the ways of the faith. May you be also the best of teachers, bearing witness to the faith by what you say and do, in Christ Jesus our Lord.

No wonder, then, that the Church understands the home to be the domestic church. It is in the intimate environment of the family that parents are, by word and example, the first heralds of the faith with respect to their children. This environment is enhanced and deepened through the parish Eucharistic community that is the heart of the spiritual life for Christian families.

Catholic schools and parish religious education programs are in partnership with the family in proclaiming and witnessing to the person and life of Jesus Christ. They assist parents in fulfilling their responsibility as the primary religious educators of their children.

Aware, then, of the dignity of this holy parental call, and with a reverent awe for that responsibility which is mine, I commit myself to be, in word and deed, the first and best teacher of my children in the faith. Practically, this means I should:

- **Understand that the authentic teachings of Jesus as taught by the Catholic Church will be part of my child's education & formation;**
- **To the best of my ability respect the teachings of the Church and help my children respect the Church and its teachings;**
- **Regularly participate in the Sunday Eucharist [if not Catholic, regularly participate in worship and prayer) with my family;**
- **Commit to speak more with my children about God and to include prayer in our daily home life;**
- **Participate in and cooperate with School or Parish School of Religion programs that enable me as a parent to take an active role in the religious education of my children, including sacramental preparation for Catholic children;**
- **Support the moral and social teachings of the Catholic Church to ensure consistency between home and school;**
- **Teach my children by word and example to have a love and concern for the needs of others;**
- **Meet my financial responsibilities in supporting the Catholic School or Parish School of Religion.**
- **Practice stewardship in support of the school and parish.**
