You will receive a confirmation notification when your registration is considered complete.





Tuition payments will be paid monthly, August through April. Tuition is based on a 177 calendar day school schedule. Holidays, snow days, breaks, etc. have been taken into consideration. Due to class size and staffing constraints, **if your child is absent**, **days cannot be rescheduled**.

A non-refundable fee of \$100 per family must be submitted with your registration.

Monthly tuition will be paid August 2019 through April 2020 by ACH (Automatic Clearing House).

If your account becomes delinquent due to transaction failure and you have not made arrangements with the Parish Business Office, **your child(ren) will not be able to return to preschool until your balance is paid in full.**
