### Rules and Expectations

- ★ Students will do their best to maintain a **respectful and positive attitude** toward the teacher and classmates just as I will do my best to show unconditional love as we are all created and loved by Christ, our risen Savior.

**What's due when?** *I don't typically post upcoming assignments as life tends to be a revolving door with unexpected weather, activities, and other things that can crop up. I do have a calendar posted in my classroom with assignments that we update throughout the week that the students are expected to keep track of for their own benefit.*

- **LATE WORK** is accepted at a 25% deduction UNLESS a note is given that day as to why its late, signed by a parent. (We understand that sometimes things just happen.)
- **Extra Credit:** Extra credit points are only given on tests and quizzes.
- **Cushion Points:** This is DIFFERENT from extra credit and is offered with nearly every homework assignment. Cushion points are extra problems offered in an assignment to increase the number of points an assignment is worth, thereby lessening how much one wrong will lower the overall percentage of the grade. UNLIKE EXTRA CREDIT, it doesn't negate the amount of problems you get wrong. HOWEVER, LIKE EXTRA CREDIT, it won't be counted wrong if the answer isn't correct. Any problem NOT assigned on a homework page are AUTOMATIC cushion points.
- Make sure **ALL ASSIGNMENTS** have your name and assignment at the top of the paper.
- All **MATH** homework is to be done in pencil, no exceptions.
- **ANY** homework that is turned in with a number of scribbles will receive a 5% deduction. (Whether a deduction is given will depend on the number of scribbles there are and how much the scribbles interfere from being able to grade the paper.) If an answer can't be found easily because the problems aren't organized well or the numbers are illegible, they will be counted wrong.
