2023 TAXES: Follow these steps to access and print last year's tax information for your records:

FACTS: (*tuition*) Log in to your account and click the blue "View Details" link. Then select the light blue "View Payment Summary" box. Select the correct year and print.

Fast Direct: (*extended care*) Log in and select "Finance" in the top blue banner. Click on the blue "Tax Report" link on the left. Select the correct year and print.
