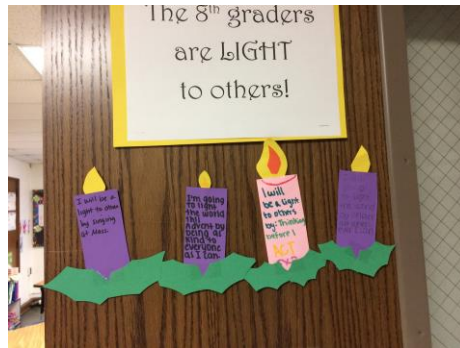

New Adams Lot Afternoon Dismissal Procedure – starting January 3, 2017

Dear Parents,

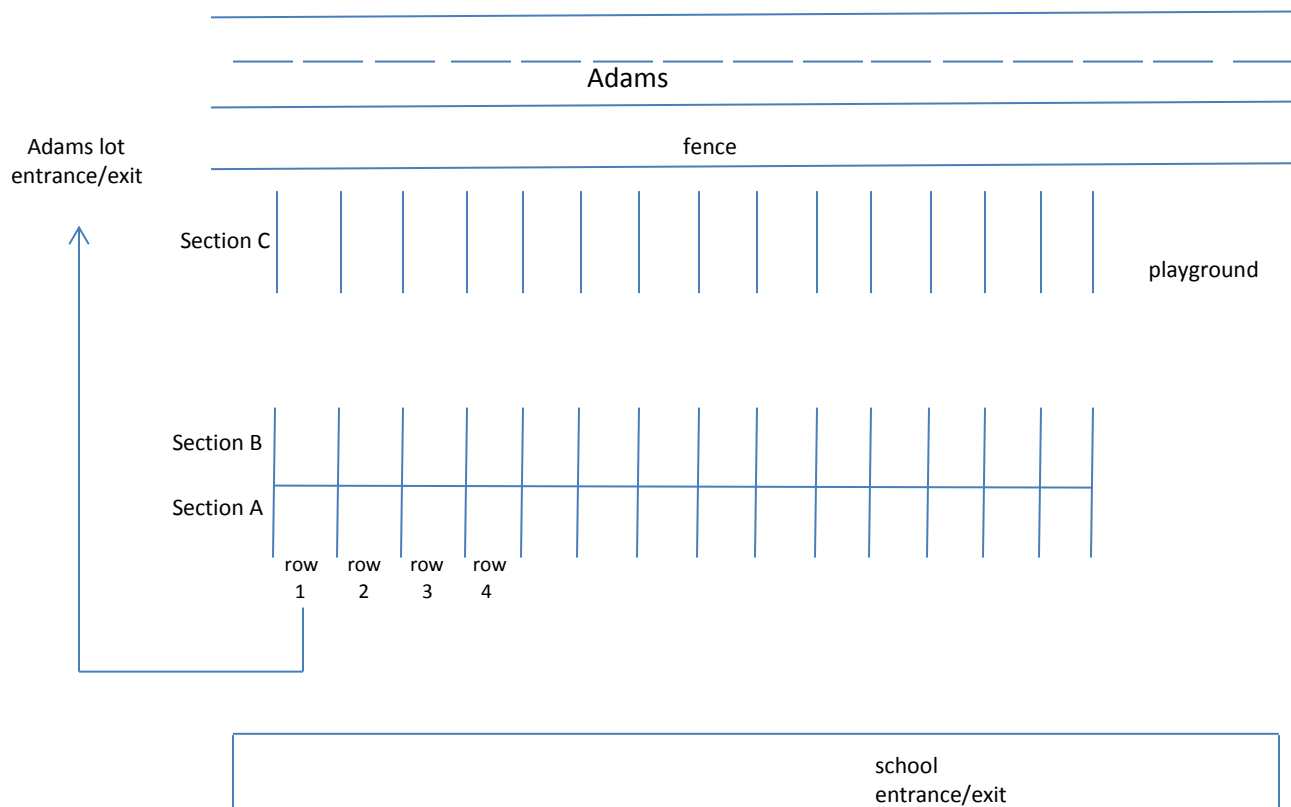
We have had concerns brought to our attention by parents, students & teachers alike regarding dismissal of the Adams lot at the end of the day. In an effort to make this dismissal procedure as efficient as possible while keeping in mind the all-important safety of your children, we would like to slightly modify the dismissal procedures at the end of the school day in the Adams lot. We ask that, especially for the first few days beginning January 3rd, we have extra patience and compassion as we work through procedures that will focus on the safety of everyone trying to leave the school in a timely manner.

We are asking that when you arrive to pick up children at dismissal to please park in section A & B in the diagram below facing the school. If you know you will not be leaving in the dismissal line when the whistle blows, please park facing the school along the fence closest to Adams. Teachers will monitor students going to their cars, as usual. Once teachers see that the students are cleared from the parking lot and no one is walking between cars, we will begin dismissing cars row by row. A teacher will guide the rows so that this may be done in an orderly and efficient manner. Row one (section A & B) will be followed by row two (section A & B), which will be followed by row three (section A & B), etc. Accordingly, if you are the first one in the parking lot, you will be the first to leave. Once all rows of section A & B are dismissed, the row of cars along the fence closest to Adams will be dismissed. This is section C.

As a reminder, the playground is closed during dismissal time. The reason for this is that we want to be sure all students are accounted for. They are either in a car or waiting with a parent/teacher for other carpool students.

Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding as we work together in this modification to our procedures.

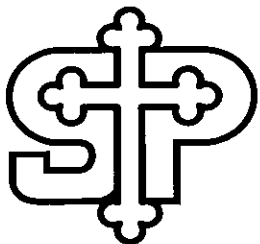

Dear Parents:

Each year it is our responsibility, as a caring Catholic community, to provide a curriculum that teaches the students appropriate boundaries and personal safety. The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People requires the Archdiocese of Saint Louis to ensure that all children in both day school and parish school of religion programs receive information that allows them to participate in their own personal safety. The curriculum, "Safe Touch", is taught by a specially trained educator or volunteer and is age appropriate. The lessons focus on safety in a non-threatening manner and consist of one class period. The goal of the curriculum is to provide students with safety tools they can use immediately. In addition, resources from Netsmartz.org may be utilized throughout the year by classroom teachers. Netsmartz.org is a free educational resource for educators and parents that provide helpful information, games, videos, and activities that reinforce technology safety in an age appropriate and fun manner.


The Safe Touch curriculum was developed in partnership with West County Psychological Associates, the Archdiocesan Child Safety Committee, as well as educators and school administrators. This year the curriculum has been updated to include technology safety and to provide more information for you as the parent. It is our hope that you take an active role to review the materials that you will be receiving at home. Please continue to reinforce these ideas and rules by asking your child questions, actively monitoring your child's online behaviors, and participating in any activities that may be sent home.

Pam Colson, our school nurse, will present the curriculum to pre-school through 2nd grade. Sr. Malia will present to 3rd-5th grades. Ms. Chauvin will present to the middle school girls, and Dr. Freitag will present to the middle school boys.

If you have any questions or would like to preview the materials prior to the curriculum being presented, please contact your child's teacher. You may also choose to "Opt Out" your child if you prefer that they receive the information from you at home. An "Opt Out" form will be provided and must be signed and returned. A parent curriculum will be provided that you can review with your child.

Your children will receive the Safe Touch Curriculum the week of **January 9-13, 2017**.

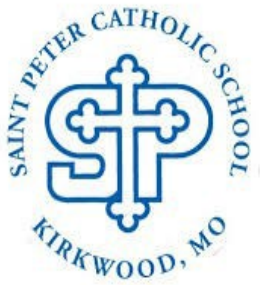
