
Wellness Council Tips for Healthy Halloween Treats

1/3 cup of organic coconut oil (or organic butter if preferred)

Instructions:

- 1. Line a muffin pan with cupcake liners. They make the process much easier. You may use a mini muffin pan or a standard muffin pan.
- 2. Place a layer of the chocolate chips on the bottom of each cupcake liner.
- 3. Heat the peanut butter and coconut oil until the coconut oil is melted.
- 4. Stir the peanut butter mixture until it is nice and smooth.
- 5. Pour the peanut butter mixture over the chocolate chips.
- 6. Freeze for about 30 minutes. Serve directly out of the freezer, and enjoy!
- 7. Store in an airtight container in the refrigerator for up to two weeks, or in the freezer for up to 6 weeks.


