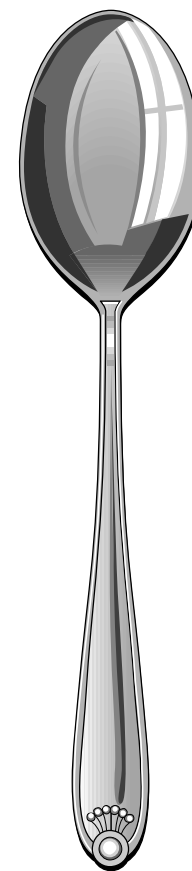
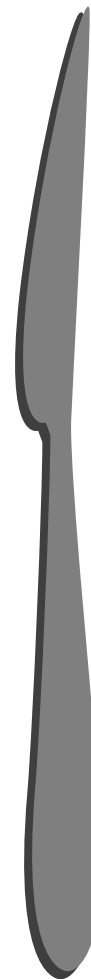
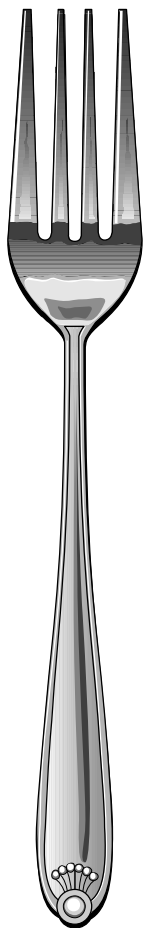

Instructions:

1. Line a muffin pan with cupcake liners. They make the process much easier.
You may use a mini muffin pan or a standard muffin pan.
2. Place a layer of the chocolate chips on the bottom of each cupcake liner.
3. Heat the peanut butter and coconut oil until the coconut oil is melted.
4. Stir the peanut butter mixture until it is nice and smooth.
5. Pour the peanut butter mixture over the chocolate chips.
6. Freeze for about 30 minutes. Serve directly out of the freezer, and enjoy!
7. Store in an airtight container in the refrigerator for up to two weeks, or in the freezer for up to 6 weeks.

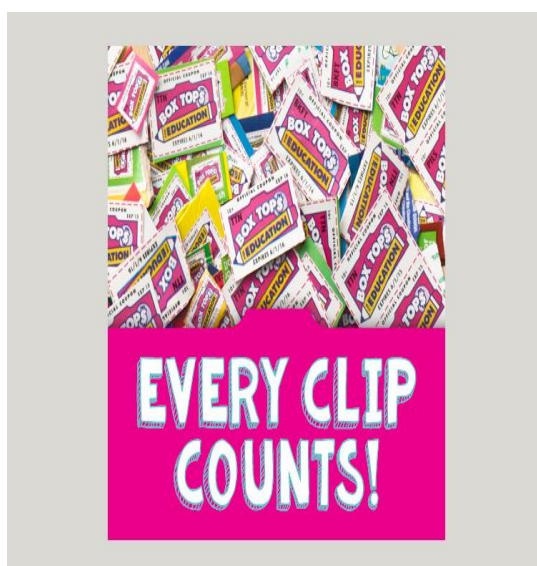

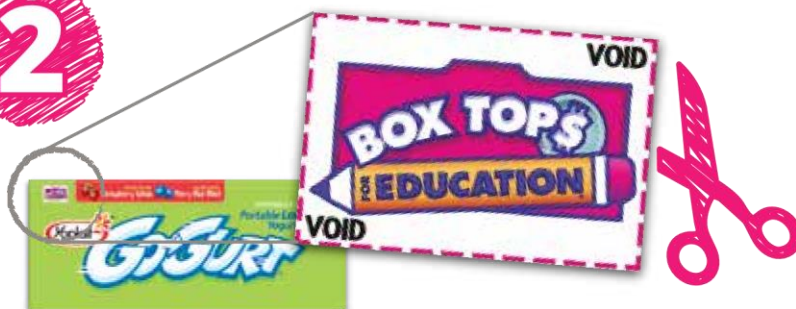

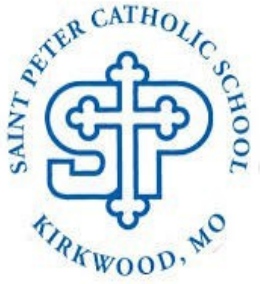
