- TUITION -

St. Rose of Lima School offers both an affordable payment plan and a most generous assistance program. Our goal is to keep finances from being an obstacle to any family who truly wants a Catholic education for their children. **Cost per child** - what it costs to educate a child at St. Rose is currently almost \$5,500. **Actual Tuition** is \$4,000 for the first child; \$3,000 for the second; and \$2,000 for the third or more. **Families are asked to pay** according to the sliding schedule given below. When calculating your family fee, you should take into account: **Family size** - includes you, your spouse, if married, all children under 18, and any elderly parents that live with you. **Household income** - is the combined income of you and your spouse, if you are married, plus payments from public assistance, social security, child support, and unemployment compensation, if applicable, and income of working parents that live with you.

There is a \$250 book/activity fee for each child. The book/activity fee is payable on the monthly plan along with tuition.

- TUITION ASSISTANCE -

St. Rose of Lima Parish subsidizes our School some 70%. We do so in order to make sending your children to our school as affordable as possible. Because of the generosity of our Parish and our various tuition assistance programs, we can generally make up for whatever our school families are not able to afford. In addition to our Parish subsidy, St. Rose of Lima School offers a number of Tuition Assistance programs available to each child. Through the generosity of our donors and supporters Adopt-An-Angel grants are given based on availability and need. "Alive In Christ", "Beyond Sunday" and "Today & Tomorrow" grants are given by the Archdiocese of St. Louis to those families who qualify. Applications for these grants can be obtained from our school office. Those who qualify are required to apply. Funds from these grants are applied to the difference between cost-per-child and family tuition. It is not deducted from tuition amounts.

Since ours is a Catholic Parochial School, preference is given first of all to our own Parishioners, then to Catholics, and then to those who are not Catholic. There is no subsidy available for book fees. Tuition/book fee payments are due on the 15th of the month in 10 equal payments from August through May. Tuition/book fees can be paid by check or cash. Cash/checks can be sent to the rectory or school office. The balance owed on tuition/fees and extended care & lunch, can be found on *fastdirect*, which you can find by clicking on the 'finance' icon at the top of the home page. If you see a minus (-) next to an amount, this means you owe that amount. If there is no minus (-), you are ahead by that amount. Any questions - just *fastdirect* Corie, Parish Bookkeeper, at the rectory and she'll walk you through it.

When choosing the amount you are able to pay, please be reasonable. It is better to choose an amount that you CAN pay rather than a higher amount that you will have to struggle with or not be able to do. When calculating the amount you will owe, be sure to leave some money in your budget for a reasonable and regular contribution to the Sunday collection.

If a student leaves St. Rose School during the school year, tuition will be pro-rated; book fees will not. No school records or report cards will be made available to anyone whose tuition/fees account is not current. No registration for the following year is complete until the tuition/fees account is current.

Our school is heavily subsidized by our annual School Auction. As a sign of your personal commitment to Saint Rose School and Catholic education, your participation in the Auction is very much needed and appreciated. If your financial circumstances improve during the school year, rather than paying additional tuition, you are urged to increase your contributions to the Sunday collection.
