Procedures for Special Education Services

First any concerns must be addressed to the parents/teacher before any communication to Fort Zumwalt is taken place. There must be communication between parents and classroom teachers addressing any academic concerns.

Then the learning consultant, classroom teacher, and parents create and implement accommodations and interventions to assess the child's academic growth. Nothing can be put in place without parental permission here at St. Theodore.

Learning consultant is responsible for submitting a request for diagnostic testing by filling out the Initial Referral Evaluation form to Fort Zumwalt School District. PARENTS MUST following the procedure and NOT CONTACT FORT ZUMWALT for an initial referral. Fort Zumwalt must receive this form from the school addressing the concerns. If they do not receive it from the school, it would appear that the school has no academic concerns and TESING can be DENIED.




