SCHOOLS

QUALIFICATIONS

Student must live in the city limits of Cape Girardeau and have an approved IEP or ISP **OR** Student must live in the city limits of Cape Girardeau and be a member of a household whose total annual income does not exceed 200% of the standard used to qualify for free & reduced lunch. Student must have either attended a public school as a full-time student for at least one semester in the last 12 months, or be entering kindergarten or first grade.

COVERAGE

MOScholars program can provide up to \$6,375 / year per student.

FUNDING

State tax credits are funding this program in our Diocese!

Besides qualifying by way of financial need, a family/student must also have:

- An approved IEP 'individualized education plan' developed under the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) or
- An individual service plan (ISP) that is developed in cooperation with a local education agency under IDEA, specifically those provisions pertaining to parentally placed private school children found in 20 U.S. Code § 1412 (a)(10) and 34 CFR § 300.132(b).

OR meet

One of the following criteria:

- Attended a public school as a full-time-student for at least one semester during the previous twelve (12) months or
- Are eligible to begin kindergarten or first grade
