**KC Free Throw Contest:**

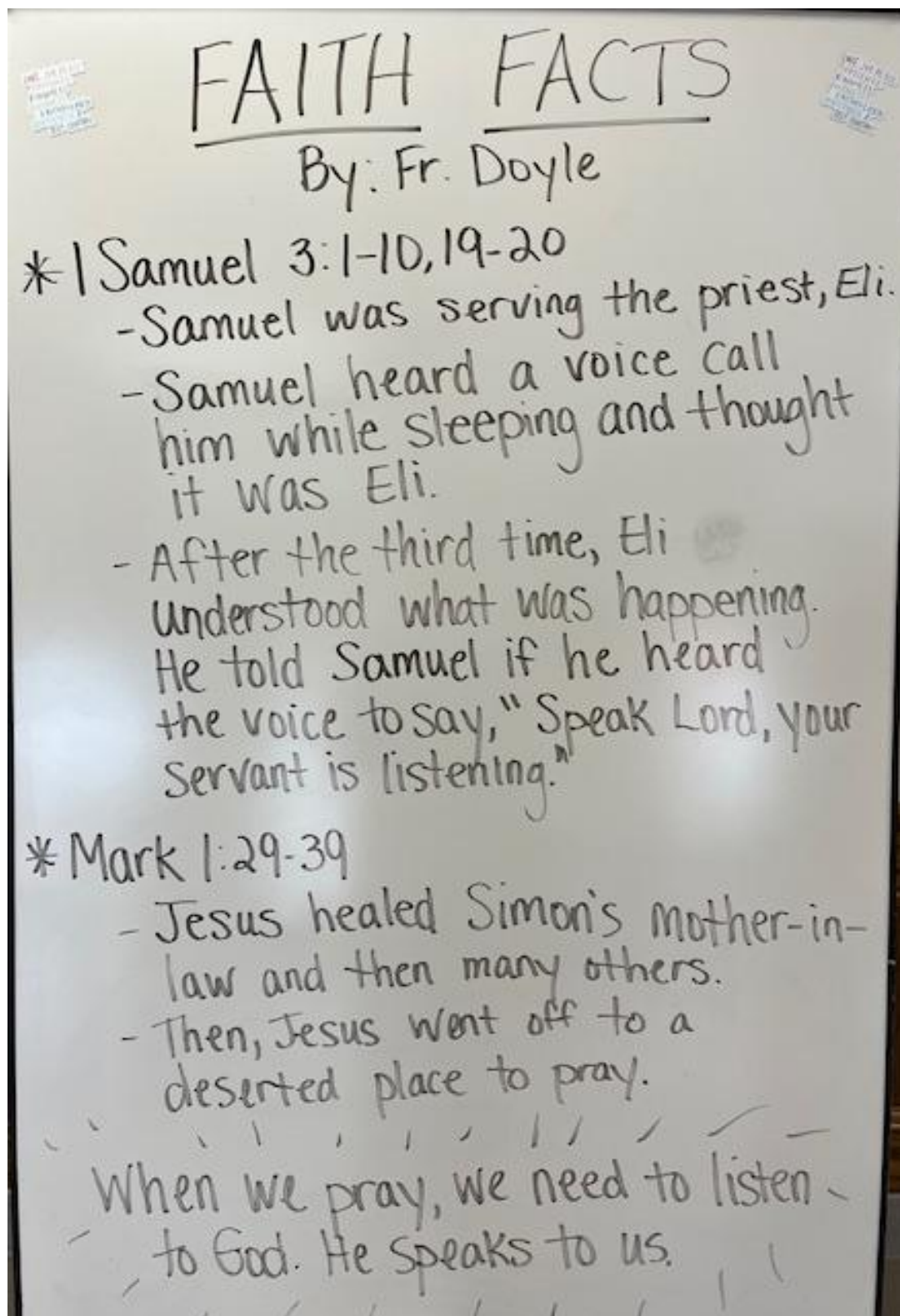

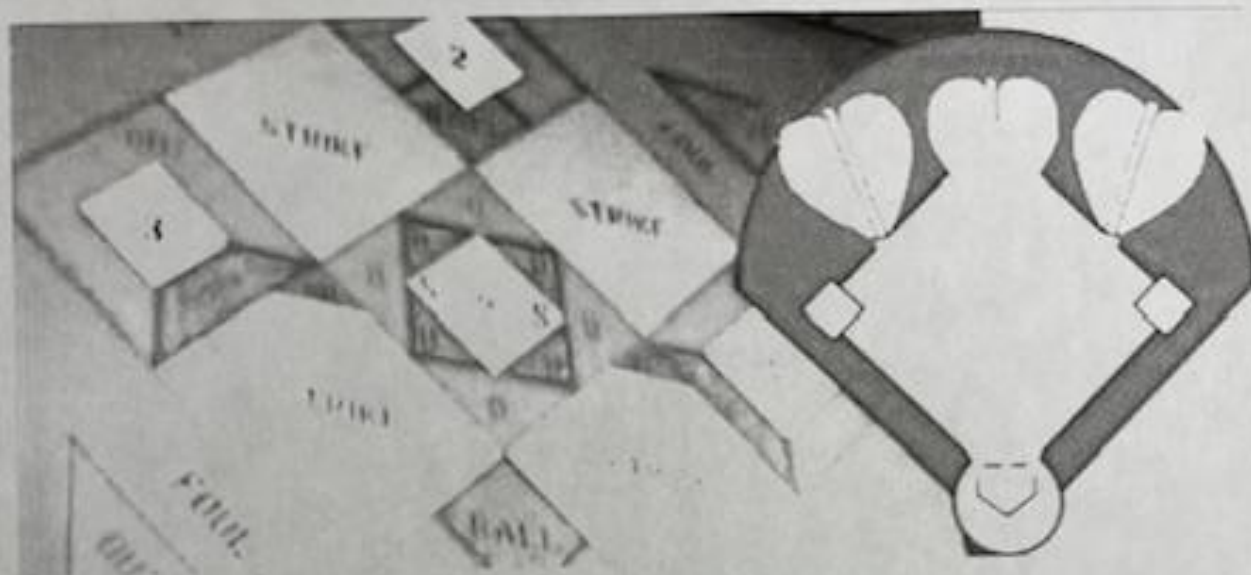
