Winter is Here:

Colder days have arrived and we do go outside. Please send in labeled coats with gloves, hats, or scarves. Reminder for K-8 Redbirds, red or navy sweatshirts or long sleeved blue polo shirts are the only outerwear allowed in the building.

Above 20 degrees: full outside recess

Inclement Weather:

If school is cancelled for inclement weather, I will send out a Fast Direct notice by 5:30am, post on our school Facebook page, and post on Channel 2. Per our Family Handbook, once school is in session, classes will not be dismissed due to weather. If the weather is questionable but not necessary for school to cancel, students will not be marked tardy until 9:00am. It is up to the parents' discretion as to whether they feel it is necessary, due to road conditions or forecast, to not bring their children or to pick them up before dismissal.


KC Free Throw Contest:



School Society Events






