- First day to apply is January 22, 2024 and deadline is February 28, 2024.
- Parents entering kindergarten, please note that Alive in Christ scholarships give preference to to NEW students, even if they are not your oldest child in school.
- Before applying for assistance from either St. Vincent or Immaculate Conception-Augusta parishes, you MUST apply for one of the TTEF Archdiocese scholarships.
- We encourage you to apply if you think you might be eligible. The scholarships are awarded on a first come, first served basis so APPLY NOW.






Relay for Life
