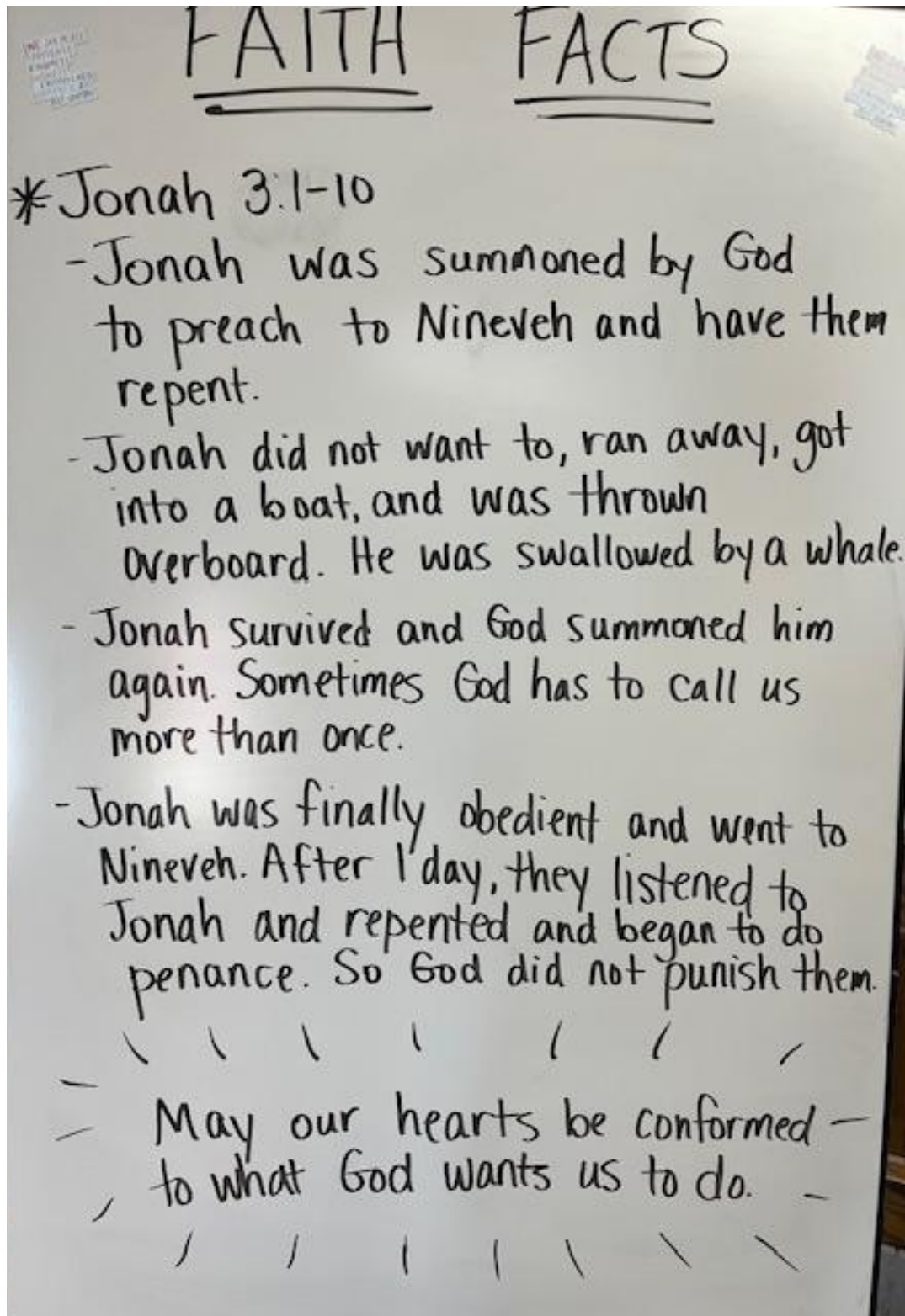
**We are blessed that the new HVAC system in the dining room is now up and running! Thank you to all who donated to the dinner auction fund-a-need to help make this possible.**

- We encourage you to apply if you think you might be eligible. The scholarships are awarded on a first come, first served basis so APPLY NOW.

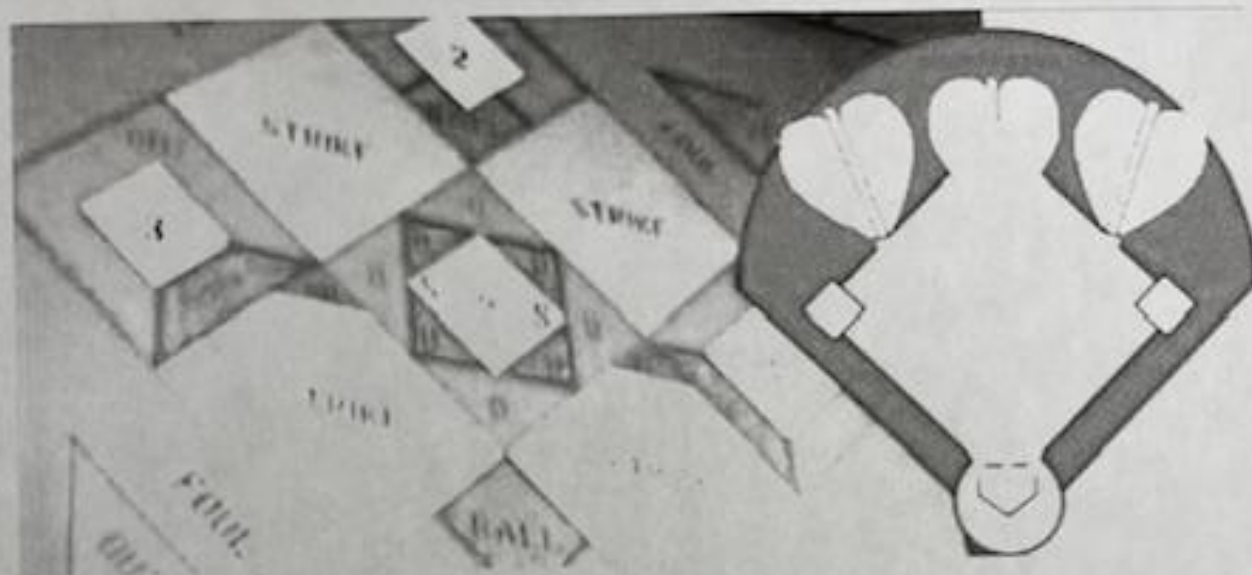

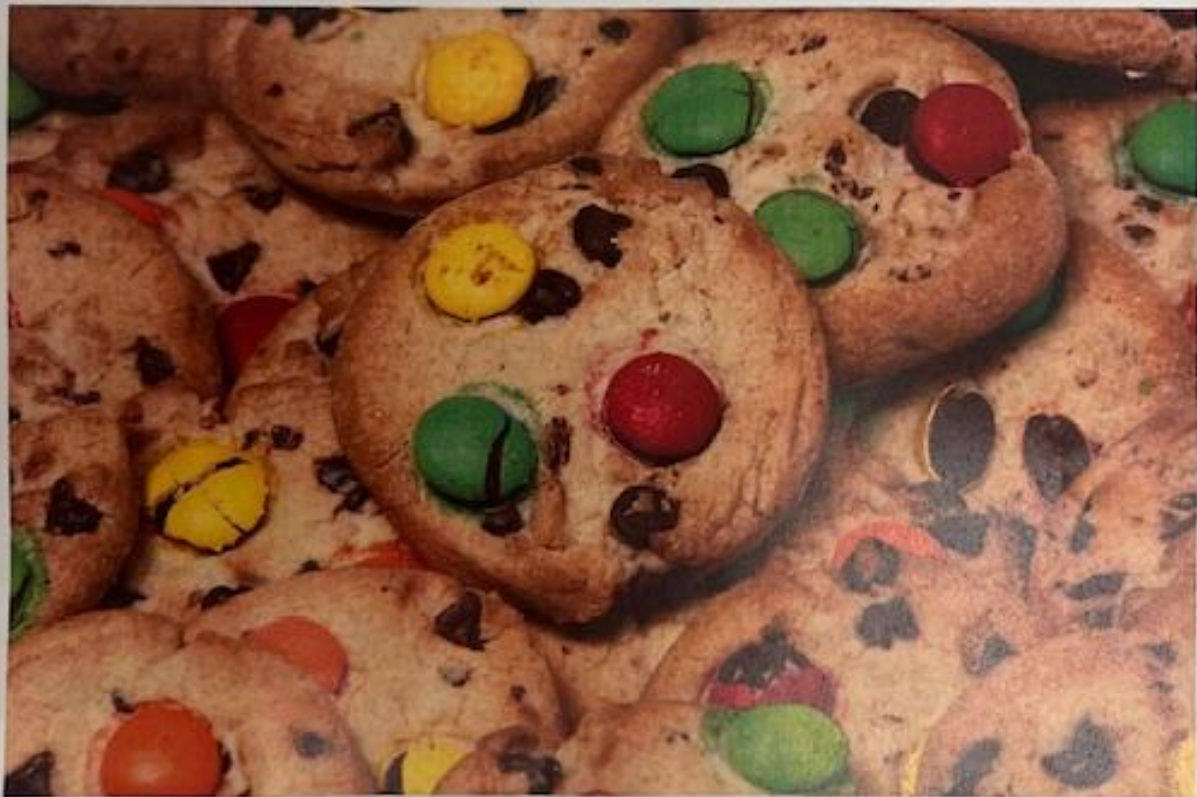
# Relay for Life
