
You are invited to join us for an evening of Lenten activities. This will be a self-paced event, so come any time between 5:30 and 7:00 to complete one or more activities.

- Your application can only be submitted online at TTEF-STL.org.
- First day to apply is January 22, 2024 and deadline is February 28, 2024.
- Parents entering kindergarten, please note that Alive in Christ scholarships give preference to NEW students, even if they are not your oldest child in school.
- Before applying for assistance from either St. Vincent or Immaculate Conception-Augusta parishes, you MUST apply for one of the TTEF Archdiocese scholarships.
- We encourage you to apply if you think you might be eligible. The scholarships are awarded on a first come, first served basis so APPLY NOW.


