Congrats to Avery Eichmeyer, who will represent SVS at the regional spelling bee @ ECC. Sydney Wilson finished second and will be the alternate.

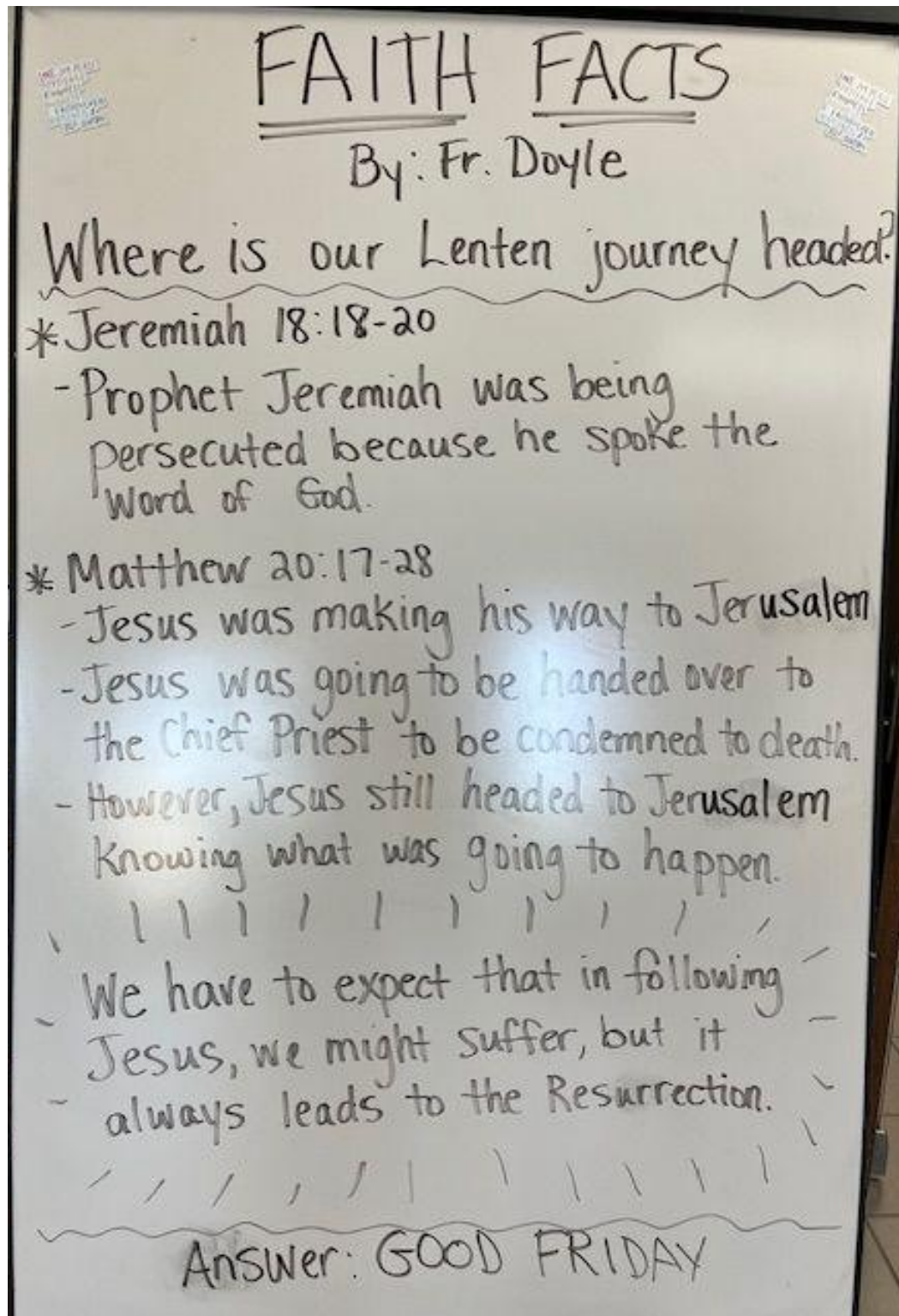


Attitude of Gratitude:

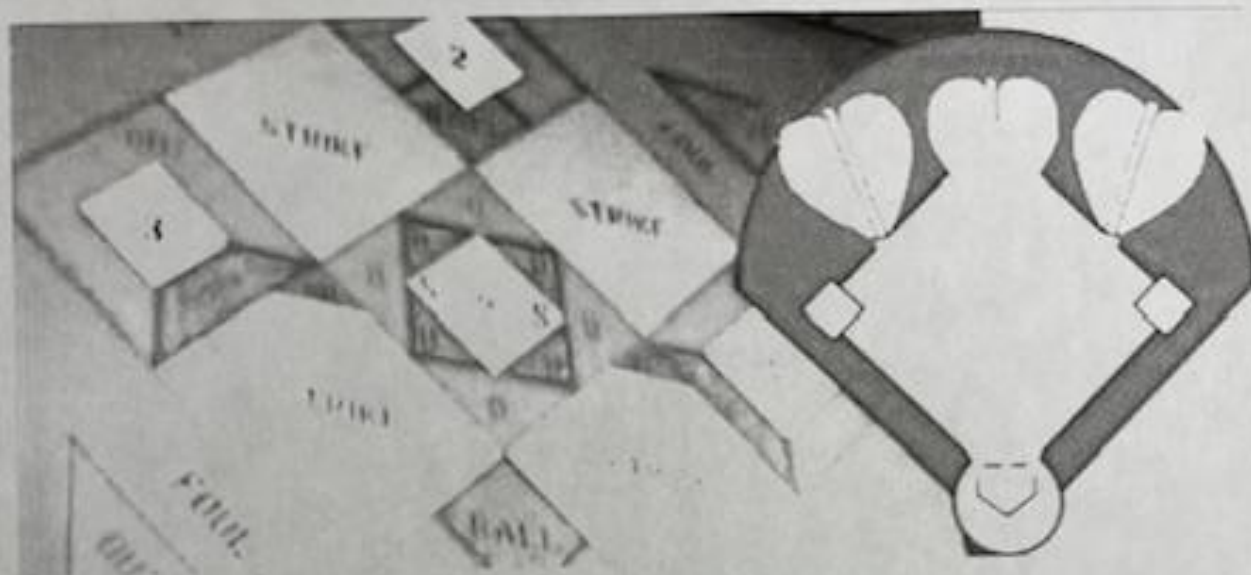

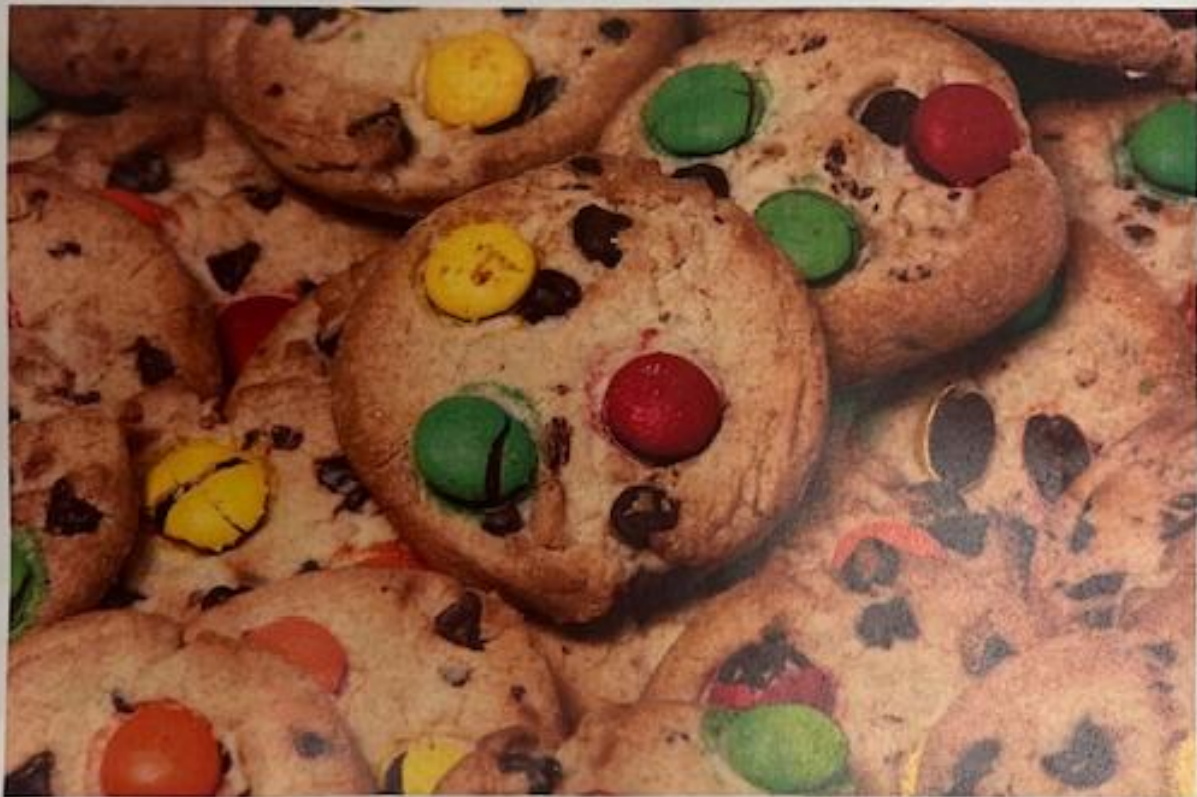
