





Please join St. Vincent's School as we "Keep Score with St. Vincent" again in 2024.

This is a fantasy baseball series that keeps track of all the National League baseball teams' scores. As a registered participant, you will receive a score card with the name of three National League baseball teams. There are 455 possible three-team combinations. Your score card is valid for the 2024 baseball season. Score cards purchased prior to opening day are eligible for 25 weekly drawings (excludes week of All-Star game and first two weeks of the season will be combined into one since season starts on a Thursday). You may purchase as many score cards as you wish even throughout the season and it will become valid the first week following your purchase.

The baseball teams' scores are recorded from the MLB website starting each Monday. We will tabulate the runs scored for each three-team combination to produce a high score and a low score for the week. The registered score card with the highest number of runs scored for that week will be awarded \$50.00. The score card with the lowest number of runs scored for that week will be awarded \$25.00.

To register for the 2024 season, please complete the form(s) on the back and return it with <u>\$25.00</u> for each card and a chance to "Keep Score with St. Vincent". The 2024 baseball season to begin for "Keep Score" is scheduled for Thursday, March 28, 2024. Send your registration in anytime, but if before March 28, you will be ready for opening day and we will send your score card to you. If you provide a valid email, your score card will be sent to you via email. <u>Please provide a valid email if possible to help us</u> <u>save on postage - Thank you!</u> Again, you can register after the season starts for \$25.00 and it will become valid the first week following your purchase.
