Religion: Chapter on Lent We finished the chapter on Lent. We will start the chapter 10 -Jesus Teaches us to Pray. Communication is an important part of life. Math: We will draw congruent shapes and designs, measure and draw line segments to the nearest inch, count nickels, and count nickels and pennies. <u>Test March</u> 7th.

English Language Arts: We will recognize spelling patterns for n't contractions, read dialogue in speech balloons with expression, add er and est to words, and compound words. Vocabulary words are audience, talent, and explain. The memory words are boy, girl, two, four, about, over, and before. They will bring home the short story, "Icky's Play" and Buster is Back." In class we will read "The Spingle Spangle Talent Show" and "Buster's Surprise. We will listen to the library books "We like Mud," "Wilma Rudolph," and "Insect Pets." Our Super Smart whiteboard story is "Puppets." Our Super-Duper Magazine is "Homer." Phonics test March 7th and 8th.
