Our Academic Updates

Religion: We will finish Chapter 15.

Chapter 17 - "We Celebrate the Resurrection" - We will act out a play for the scripture Mark 16:1-8. We will also make a butterfly to remind us of new life. Butterflies start out as caterpillars, and then go into their cocoon and come out with new life as a butterfly. This is just like when Jesus comes out of the tomb with new resurrected life.

Math: We will learn to identify and count quarters, subtract two-digit numbers, identify cold, warm, and hot temperatures and read to nearest 10 degrees, subtracting half of a double. We are taking our test for Lesson 25 on Monday or Tuesday. We will take Lesson 30 next week on Monday or Tuesday.

English Language Arts: We will learn the combination /ar/, /or/, /er/, /ur/, /ir/ sounds, suffix /ful/, characters, setting, problem, solution of a story. Our memory words are both, again, laugh, cold, does, and know. The vocabulary words are vast, fear and report. The short stories are "Party Planning", and "Sal and the Fire Department.
