5th and 6th grade Religion : We have completed all the readings and activities for chapter 13. On Monday of this week we will review and on Tuesday we will take the test. Study guide is posted on the bulletin board and in Google classroom. On Thursday we will begin on chapter 14. Chapter 14 examines John 3:11-18, and focuses on how love is the great commandment in Christian Life.

8th grade ELA: The 8th grade has one chapter left in *Bridge to Terabithia*. When we complete chapter 13 we will go over the comprehension questions and vocabulary for the fourth section of the book and then watch the film version of Katherine Paterson's story. Students have requested and been given permission for popcorn during the movie.

7th Grade ELA: The seventh grade have only one chapter left to read in Gordon Gorman's *The Unteachables*. We have a section 4 vocabulary and a comprehensive test on the book in order to wrap up this literature unit.

7th and 8th Biology: 7th and 8th grade have completed lesson one and two which dealt with fossil evidence and natural selection. On Friday we took the test on these two lessons and have only one lab left before moving on to the biological aspects of evolution. This lesson covers subjects like comparative anatomy and vestigial structures.

5th and 6th Science: 5 and 6 science have completed lesson one and lesson two of chapter 5. On Friday (after the vocabulary test) we began on a project which will feature all the steps in the water cycle. Students will have class time on Monday and Tuesday to work on the project which is due on Wednesday of this week (Wednesday we will begin our presentations). Students do have a paper guide for this project and I have posted the guide on Google classroom.
