## WI private school tuition credit

Tax Day is coming up on April 18, 2017. Don't forget to claim your private school tuition tax deduction! Thanks to advocacy by WCRIS, state law allows Wisconsin parents to deduct private school tuition on their taxes.

Regardless of income, parents and legal guardians are eligible for a maximum deduction of $\$ 4,000$ per child in grades K-8 and $\$ 10,000$ per child in grades 9-12. Students transitioning from eighth to ninth grade are eligible for both deductions. The Schedule PS is available for download by following: www.revenue.wi.gov/DORForms/2016SchedulePS.pdf

Scrip credits will be sent home the week of February 6th.
