Notes From Pastor GeRue

WI private school tuition credit

Tax Day is coming up on April 18, 2017. Don't forget to claim your private school tuition tax deduction! Thanks to advocacy by WCRIS, state law allows Wisconsin parents to deduct private school tuition on their taxes.

Regardless of income, parents and legal guardians are eligible for a maximum deduction of \$4,000 per child in grades K-8 and \$10,000 per child in grades 9-12. Students transitioning from eighth to ninth grade are eligible for both deductions. The Schedule PS is available for download by following: <u>www.revenue.wi.gov/DORForms/2016-</u> SchedulePS.pdf

WHAT IS LENT AND WHY?

Lent starts Wednesday, March 1. Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday. Lent comes from the Anglo Saxon word *lencten*, which means "spring." The forty days represents the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry.

Lent is a time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. It is a time of selfexamination and reflection. In the early church, Lent was a time to prepare new converts for baptism. Today, Christians focus on their relationship with God, often choosing to give up something or to volunteer and give of themselves for others.

Sundays in Lent are not counted in the forty days because each Sunday represents a "mini-Easter" and the reverent spirit of Lent is tempered with joyful anticipation of the Resurrection.
