

#### God working in a new exciting way here at Trinity, and He's using ALPHAI <u>Come and see!</u>

"In addition to the Adult ALPHA, and at the same time, there will also be a Youth ALPHA for teens, led by teens! The content in the Youth ALPHA videos is more specifically applicable to the lives of teenagers today. But, just like the adult ALPHA, our primary focus is going to be strengthening our faith and building relationships with one another. This is a time to discuss our doubts, opinions and questions.

Youth ALPHA invites us to discuss questions of life and faith with people of every belief or mindset in a safe, non-confrontational environment.

Each week we watch a video that shares evidence and stories that address things like "How do we know Jesus was who he said he was?", "Is faith blind, based on feelings or beliefs you were taught as a child or can it be backed by facts?" After the video, each small group talks about the information shared. This is where the Holy Spirit is having the biggest impact on participants. We see how the power of the relationships built during this time is changing people's lives...relationships with Him and with each other.

When you <u>Come and See</u> and understand how the Holy Spirit works through Youth ALPHA you will be encouraged to tell others about it. If you have someone in your life you would like to share Jesus with but don't know how to do it without seeming judgmental or are concerned about it damaging your friendship, Youth ALPHA can help. Inviting them to Youth ALPHA leaves you in the position of being a friend while the videos present a thoughtful message that can help lead them to Christ.

We understand summer schedules are busy so please don't worry if you can't come every Sunday. Just like with the Adult ALPHA, we will be able to send you the videos so you won't miss anything while you are away. We would love to see you there and please bring friends.

# **Conscious Dicipline**

Helpful Hints:

1.Picture Routines at home are very helpful. The brain is pattern-seeking, so children know what is coming next and feel safe. Without the pattern, anxiety is felt. Visual routines help create safety.

2. It takes 2,000 times in context for lessons to be learned. It takes time and patience for children to learn something new.

3. No one can make you angry without your permission. You choose how you are going to react when you are upset. In the classroom, we teach students safe ways to help manage their anger.
