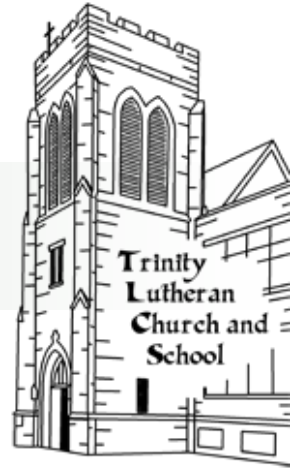

Scrip Notes

Scrip hours for the Christmas Holiday are as follows:

Monday-Thursday next week, normal office hours.

Friday, Dec 23rd both office are open 8am-Noon only.

Church Office Only Open: Tues, Dec 27th 8am-Noon, Wed, Dec 28th 8am-Noon, Thurs, Dec 29th 8am-Noon.

Both Offices Closed: Mon, Dec 26th & Fri, Dec 30th.

All classes & regular hour resume on Tues, Jan 3rd.

You can still order Scrip on Monday and it will be here by Thursday (as long as Fed Ex delivers on time). We will be fully stocked as we go into the final stretch next week.

The current Scrip credit earning period will end on January 23rd, and once we've calculated credits, you will receive notification of your Scrip credit, which will allow you to apply it toward February's tuition or use at a later date, or bank it for next school year.

If you need to pick up or drop off your child after 8:30pm, you must enter through door #7 on Tayco Street. All students dropped off after 8:30 will need a pass tardy pass to get to class.
