Special Instructions: Parents are welcome to chaperone. They must also pay \$30 for a ticket. There is space for up to 30 parent chaperones. Please wear weather appropriate clothing. Students may wear non-uniform clothing that is an appropriate representation of the school and adheres to non-uniform dress code policies. We will only stay for a portion of the game. Dear parents,

We have a wonderful opportunity to not only see a Brewers game but also a chance to learn about weather! This chance is coming up on **Wednesday, April 17th**. It is an all-day trip and we will take a bus. The program is **only offered to grades 3-8**.

Here are the details about the event.

- **Grades 3-8**
  - Weather presentations start at 9:30 a.m.
    - Students will be grouped off with an adult chaperone to see all the weather displays in the main halls.
    - Chaperones need to be willing to be in charge of up to 3-4 students during that portion of the event.
    - Students will also be told that their adult chaperone is also the one to assist in taking them to the restroom or concession stand.
  - Brewer game starts at 12:40 p.m. (We will be staying for most of the game.)
  - **To cover costs for seating and busing, each student must pay \$20.**
    - Tickets include a hot dog and a bottle of water.
  - Arrival at school is 7:10 a.m.
  - Depart for Miller Park by 7:30 a.m.
  - Return to buses no later than 3:30 p.m.
  - Back to school around 5:30 p.m.
  - **Chaperones are welcome to come and must pay \$30 each.**
    - Chaperones also ride on the bus.
  - If a student brings money for concessions or a souvenir, they are responsible for it.
- **Grades PS3-2<sup>nd</sup>**
  - They will have a regularly scheduled school day.

A permission slip will be going home for the trip. If a 3rd-8<sup>th</sup> grade student is unable to participate, that student will be required to complete a grade appropriate, weather-related assignment. More information will come on that as needed. Please contact Mrs. Maloney or Pastor Gerue if you should need financial assistance.
