Mother's Day

In the 3rd Article of the Apostles' Creed, we confess that we believe in "the Holy Christian Church." We often refer to the church with feminine pronouns because in Scripture, the Church is called the Bride of Christ and is sometimes compared to a mother.

Mothers give life and nurture, and that is precisely what the Church does. God uses women to carry out the astonishing task of giving birth. It really is quite an honor. God uses what seems so ordinary to accomplish something quite extraordinary. That's the way it is with the "new birth" of Baptism, too. It comes through the Church, our spiritual mother. She baptizes. She teaches. She nurtures. She gathers her children as a hen gathers her chicks under her wing. She worries. She protects. She provides a home.
