#### Follow Me

In the earliest days of the church, whenever believers referred to themselves, they used the word disciple. To be a disciple is to be a follower, but not casually, as on social media. To be a disciple means that you are committed—no matter what the cost, When Jesus called Peter, Andrew, James, and John, they left their nets to go and follow Jesus. They left their past behind. That's what a disciple does.

The call to be a disciple is always a call of God's grace. None of Jesus' disciples was a likely candidate for the job. Every one of them was entirely unqualified to be an apostle. He calls undeserving sinners to work in his kingdom—just as he has called you and me.

When Jesus called Matthew, he told him, "Follow me," and that's what Matthew did. Then Matthew invited his friends and neighbors to meet Jesus. They came, and their lives were forever changed. Your call to be a disciple is not just to follow Jesus privately. It is to confess him publicly, too...and to bring friends and others along to meet their Savior. So be a follower: follow Jesus. And be a leader: lead others to know him.
